

KEŽMAROK city information

#### history

The Town of Kežmarok – in the past known as a free royal town, nowdays one of the 17 Urban Heritage Reservations in Slovakia, important center of cultural life in the region of Spiš, county seat and significant tourist destination near-by the High Tatras Mountains.

The origin of the town dates back to the 13th century – in those times the unification of the Slavic and German settlements occured. First literary record from 1251, in 1269 the town obtained the privileges of the free royal town (the right to organise two annual fairs, the right to stock, ius gladii, the right to use its own coat-of-arms etc., all gained during 15th century). Forty guilds were active in the town until 19th century – Kežmarok belonged to the most important economical center of the Medieval Hungary.

Also the architecture reflects the long – more than 730-year-old – existence of the town that is considered a treasury of historical monuments as the Evangelical Wooden Church from 1717 and the Lyceum from 1776 (both oficial National Cultural Monuments), the Basilica of the Saint Cross with valuable campanile (Renaissance), picturesque houses in the old town or unusual building of the New Evangelical Church.

#### geography

The climate is moderate – more continental than oceanic – with cold winters and occasional rapid weather changes caused by neighborhood of the mountains (the High Tatras, Gerlach 2655 m). The elevation above sea level is 626 m.

The environs of Kežmarok are very woody (pine Pinus sylvestris, spruce Picea abies, larch Larix decidua), only smaller part of the area is agriculturally exploited – mostly to grow potatoes, cereal, fodder, flax. The animal kingdom is relatively poor (more usual is fox Vulpes Vulpes, wild hare Lepus europaeus, smaller species of deer).
